A significant reduction in numbers from the 620 ponies put through the sale yard in the two sales in September last year but still very little trade for the foals, despite the free micro chipping service provided by the New Forest Livestock Society through the Verderers Shceme. The heavy morning rain certainly did not help the look of the foals which had come through a hard summer already and it was only the best which produced any sort of spark to a top of 190 gns for Erika Lovell's bay colt foal to make 14.2hh. A good demand for the older registered and part bred geldings with these taking preference over the crossbred ponies in section 4, with a top price for the day of 625 gns for a 3 y.o. registered bay gelding, broken to ride, from regular away supporter Lee Lawrence. Our thanks go to the New Forest Livestock Society Committee and handlers for all their hard work in organising and carrying out the sale and the micro chipping, which did not delay the selling with the new squeeze crush working very well. However, the plan to sell all the foals first, although good in principle, did cause a few problems and will be reviewed prior to the next sale.
