Another beautiful day for Beaulieu Road, we have been blessed so far this year, and a better trade than September helped again by the foal show and the quality of entries. Despite the sudden change in the passport regulations numbers and prices were similar to the same time last year except for the colt foals which were at less money as expected. A real shortage of filly foals, only one in the registered section, but this one was the overall champion in the show so congratulations to Jon Gerrelli in following Maureen Rayner's success last year, with his reward spirited bidding to 540 guineas. Nicky Stephens' class winning gelding reached 420 guineas whilst top price colt was Charlie Maton's strong roan at 355 guineas. There was a good trade for the older ponies, both foresters and others, with a couple of believed record sale prices as detailed below in the report.

Our thanks to this year's judge Paul Armitage and to the New Forest Livestock Society for their hard work in organising the show and sale.

Please note the next sale is on Thursday 6th December when all ponies will have to be presented with a full passport. There will be a pre-sale chipping event at Beaulieu Road on Saturday 24th November at 9.30 am for eligible ponies. The cost of chipping will be £15 a head, refundable if the ponies are sold in the December sale. The usual non-refundable passport application fee will also apply.
