A much smaller entry than the same day last year but a packed ring and plenty of bidders and prices well advanced on last year with the colt foals in particular more keenly sought after. Older registered ponies reached good levels, probably similar to last year, whilst amongst the other breeds those horses that had been broken to ride received a real premium up to a possible record 2,200 guineas. Shetlands and donkeys also a marvellous trade, completely different to a year ago. The next sale will be on Thursday 31st October.
