Trade: A busy and successful day in the Sale Yard with a good show and plenty of customers for the foals in particular. I had to look back to October 2019 to find a similar sale in the yard with a foal show included and in that sale Section 1 Colt Foals averaged about £114, so in the 5 year period the price has more than trebled. Interestingly that report referred back to a sale in October 2014 when Colt Foals averaged about £35 so they have increased more than ten times in ten years, we shouldn't forget how difficult trade has been at times over the years ! As usual, this year colour and potential to make 14 hands plus were deciding factors in the top priced foals. Many thanks to the New Forest Livestock Society and Publicity Group for organising the show and especially to Michael Goddard for judging. The full list of results and prices is shown below. Outside of the show, older ponies in the registered section sold to £1500 for Adam Coutts' strong 3 year old Gelding 'Durleyfarm Merlin', Danny Pettyfer's 4 year old Gelding sold at £1290, Tristan Ingram's 3 year old Gelding at £1200 and the only Mare entered, from James Gerrelli, £1300. Part Breds made to £1500 for Kay McGoldrick's Appaloosa cross whilst in Section 4 there was a very firm trade for the biggest entry of Donkeys seen for many a day. Kay also made £1540 with a Quarter Horse x Welsh x New Forest Yearling Filly but top price of the day was £1600 paid for a very pretty Skewbald Cob x 2 Year Old Filly from Sarah Harrison and led by experienced YouTube Foal handler Patrick Langdown.
